REGULAR SESSION OCTOBER 20, 2025

The Board of Nemaha County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, October 20, 2025 in the Commissioner's Room of the Nemaha County Courthouse. The meeting was called to order with Co-Chairman Ben Glace leading the flag salute. Present also was Commissioner Joe Dalinghaus and County Clerk Mary Kay Schultejans recording the minutes. Chairman Jason Koch and County Counselor/County Administrator Austin Parker were both absent from today's meeting.

Ben Glace led those present in an opening prayer to begin the meeting this morning.

The board set the agenda for today's meeting. Joe Dalinghaus moved to approve the agenda for October 20, 2025 as presented. Ben Glace seconded the motion. The motion carried with all voting aye.

The board reviewed the minutes from the October 13, 2025 meeting. Joe Dalinghaus moved to approve the minutes as presented. Ben Glace seconded the motion. The motion carried with all voting aye.

Co-Chairman Ben Glace called for Open Public Forum to begin at 9:12 am. Janell Niehues came before the board to speak during today's forum. Co-Chairman Ben Glace ended public forum at 9:26 am.

Joe Dalinghaus moved to approve the purchase of a pallet of ice melt from Suther Building Supply in the total amount of \$779.10. Ben Glace seconded the motion. Ben added that the county will continue to try to use multiple local vendors for purchases. The motion carried with all voting aye.

Commissioners called and spoke to Senior Services/Public Transit Director Marie Weaver about the condition of a stove at the Nutrition Center. Joe Dalinghaus moved to formally accept the \$5,000 donation from Ag Partners to be used in part to purchase a replacement stove for use by the Nemaha County Nutrition Department in its preparation of meals in Seneca and to authorize County Administrator Parker to issue the provided letter acknowledging receipt of this donation. Ben Glace seconded the motion. Ben added that the Commission wanted to thank Ag Partners for this donation and stated that the county will be seeking bids for the purchase of a new stove. The motion carried with all voting aye.

Ben Glace moved to authorize the purchase of six LT245/75R17 10 ply Firestone Transforce AT-2 tires at \$158.08 each from C&K Service. Joe Dalinghaus seconded the motion. The motion carried with all voting aye.

Ben Glace stated that the Health Department is working with KDHE to provide purchase documentation from grant purchases made several years ago. County Counselor/County Administrator Austin Parker will request assistance from NCCHS in providing this documentation.

Commissioners called and spoke to County Counselor/County Administrator Austin Parker. Austin stated that he would like the Commission to act on the Purchasing Policy next week and to commit on the EMS building site soon.

Road and Bridge/Solid Waste Report:

Road and Bridge/Solid Waste Supervisor Adam Kuckelman submitted a written report advising the board that:

- he is getting hard bids for the micro surface of Old Highway 9 from Dustrol, Vance, and Pro-Seal.
- his crew is putting in tubes at this time.

The board reviewed vouchers submitted by the different departments to be paid this week. Joe Dalinghaus moved to approve the AP warrants to be paid on October 20, 2025 as presented. Ben Glace seconded the motion. The motion carried with all voting aye.
