#### **Objectives of the event**

The objective of the multiplier event was to present the overall work that has been done during the project's lifetime and, more specific, the three intellectual outputs that have been produced. The event aimed at making participants reflect on the concepts of gender-based violence, restorative justice, and media education by expressing their views, concerns and experiences. The event also aimed at providing the participants with the ability to connect the material created with their work, in a practical and useful way. The intellectual outputs designed should not only be of theoretical value, but also have a practical application when working with young people. Our objective was also to make participants realize the importance of this work, so they recommend the intellectual outputs created in other youth workers and colleagues, keeping in mind that gender-based violence incidents increased in Greece during the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### **Agenda**

The day began at 9.00 a.m. with each participant's registration, in compliance with the COVID-19 regulations in Greece, to gain access to the event's facilities. The event started at 9.30 with the initial greetings of Mr. Panagiotis Amoiridis, director of EPIMORFOTIKI KILKIS. Then, Mrs. Tatiana Iliadou, a lawyer with over 25 years of experience in penal law and adult education, presented the Erasmus+ programme and the C4C Project and its specific objectives, with particular references to gender-based violence and restorative justice. Mr. Nicolas Georgiadis, an informatics and telecommunications engineer, guided the participants through I.O. 1 "Competencies framework" and the "Self-assessment tool" and I.O. 2 "Giving us a Chance: Accredited E-courses", with particular references to media education. Mrs. Tatiana Iliadou completed the presentation with I.O. 3 "Giving us a Chance e-book", followed by a short presentation of other European projects in which EPIMORFOTIKI KILKIS participated. A lunch break was offered to the participants at 12.00 and after the break a discussion followed until the end of the event at 13.45.

#### **Organisation**

How the event was disseminated

The event was disseminated through telephone contacts and e-mails. Due to restricted measures because of the pandemic, the number of people in the facilities had to be limited. Our organization contacted several target groups, including co-workers who piloted the IOs and participated in the focus group, teachers and adult trainers, working with young people.

How the pre-registration took place

Registration for the event took place through telephone contacts, where participants could confirm their presence. The event was free of charge.

#### Location and facilities

The multiplier event took place at the premises of EPIMORFOTIKI KILKIS, 56 Doiranis str., 61100 Kilkis.

#### **Implementation**

The event took place in the central classroom of our organisation's premises. The event started with registration, where participants filled their name on the registration sheets and added e-mail, address and signature (appendix 2). The speakers shared slides of their presentations with the participants.

Mr. Panagiotis Amoiridis, director of EPIMORFOTIKI KILKIS greeted the participants and thanked them for their participation.

Mrs. Tatiana Iliadou, a lawyer with over 25 years of experience in penal law and adult education, presented the Erasmus+ programme and the C4C Project and its specific objectives, with particular references to gender-based violence and restorative justice. Mr. Nicolas Georgiadis, an informatics and telecommunications engineer, guided the participants through I.O. 1 "Competencies framework" and the "Self-assessment tool" and I.O. 2 "Giving us a Chance: Accredited E-courses", with particular references to media education and tools youth worker can use, to communicate messages against gender-based violence more easily.

Mrs. Tatiana Iliadou completed the presentation with I.O. 3 "Giving us a Chance e-book", followed by a short presentation of other European projects in which our organisation participated.

After the lunch break, a fruitful discussion followed, where participants shared their experiences from their work with young people until the end of the event at 13.45.

#### **Participants**


In total, 21 participants from Greece attended the multiplier event, 9 women and 12 men.


1) How would you evaluate the whole event

Average: 4,89




2) How would you evaluate the information you received before the event

Average: 4,39




3) How would you evaluate the organization of the event

Average: 4,83




# 4) The event was worthy of my expectations

Average: 4,56




# 5) The topics were relevant to my interests

Average: 4,28




# 6) The activities that were implemented were interesting

Average: 4,67




## 7) I could understand easily the topics/tools presented
