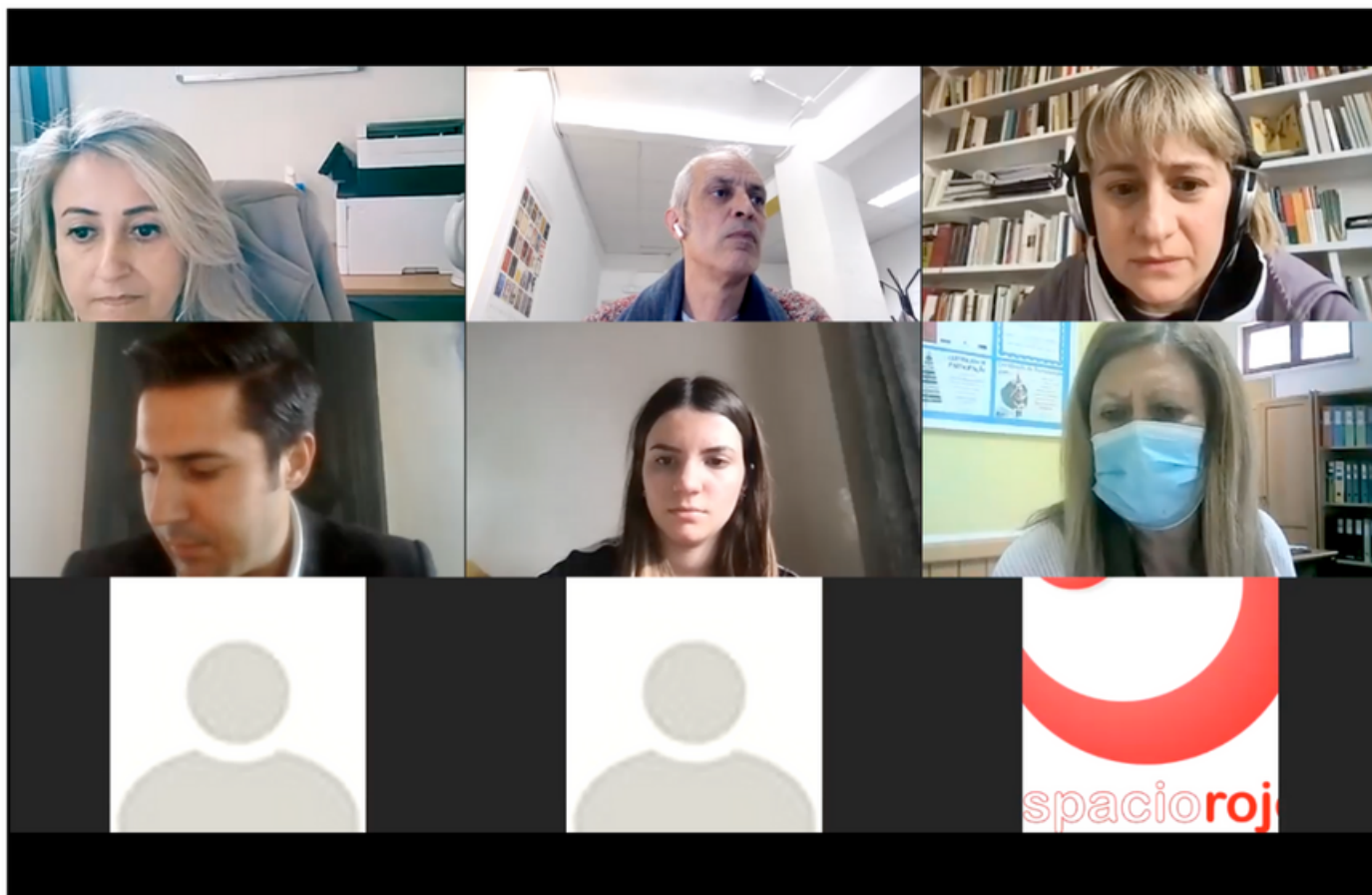
PILOT IMPLEMENTATION HAS STARTED...

TRAINING COURSE AND PROJECT MEETING

Last February 2022, we held an online Learning Training and Teaching activity in the frame of 'Our Culture' project.

The aims of these 5 days were to explain different methodologies, experiential learning as well as creative drama and art-based learning in order to produce activities such our coming pilot within partners countries.

We ended up creating a common language and plan. Thus, we increased synergy, cooperation and motivation among partners.
