The E-book (IO3)

This comparative paper brings together all the research, pilots, learning and findings of the project into one e-book that integrates the theoretical and practical results of the programme including its pilots, training and on the ground learning from each participating country and Europe. It highlights the overall outcome as well as best practices and policy recommendations for those serving offenders, ex-offenders or people at risk of marginalisation and violent radicalisation/group offending.

The **RDaVR e-book** is the ultimate pride of the consortium since it is the first in the area, paving the way for Europe. The e-book reflects upon the project in its entirety and is its biggest legacy.



RDaVR has been running for more than two years and was put together to provide an alternative positive policy approach to preventing violent radicalisation and extremism based on dialogue and Restorative Justice (RJ). The key objective of this E-book is to overview the implementation of RDaVR in all partners' countries, to identify the emerged training needs of criminal justice professionals in the field, to compare and explore partners' approaches and piloting results and to reflect on all the evaluation conclusions, coming up collectively with the best practices pinpointed in all countries.

On 14th February 2023, the RDaVR Closing International Multiplier Event in the UK will takes place, marking the final phase of the project, focused on the planning and holding of Multiplier Events in all involved countries of the consortium.

The RDaVR Closing International Multiplier Event, entitled "Pro-social value systems: resilience, dialogue and trust-building", is organised by Restorative Justice for All International Institute at the RJ4All Rotherhithe Community Centre, 30 Plough Way, London SE16 2LJ. This closing international event aims to bring together local and international participants in order to present the project activities, results and outcomes as well as the learning from the project itself, securing knowledge-sharing, networking and practical activities through interactive workshops.

The RDaVR Closing Multiplier Event in the UK is built upon an initial presentation of the project's results and impact, entitled *Raising awareness about radicalisation & developing pro-social value systems*, and follow-up user-led workshops, with a focus on team building, maintaining trust, and strengthening resilience. The event is organised using the values of restorative justice such as dialogue and power sharing.
