RESTORATIVE JUSTICE MUSIC: A TOOL FOR SOCIAL COHESION

Closing the social exclusion gaps by adapting the Restorative Justice Music programme, including underlying values of restorative justice of equality, social inclusion, diversity, power sharing and non-discrimination.

Restoring Respect through Music Education" (RRME), an Erasmus+ funded project working in partnership with organisations in Spain, Turkey, the UK, Germany, and Cyprus. RRME aimed to close the gap through the concept of Restorative Justice Music by promoting music programmes based on the underlying values of restorative justice, equality, social inclusion, diversity, power sharing and non-discrimination. The project delivered a face-to-face training programme drawn from the experience of teachers and educational professionals to aid the integration of children from migrant backgrounds and children at risk of exclusion. In addition, a certified e-course for teachers and educators to assist them in integrating pupils and young people through a restorative justice social action music programme.
