3. Organisation

The Multiplier event took place in the city of Peristeri in a hall booked for 30 participants. The invitation of the event was disseminated through EDRA's website to all its followers and partners. Potential participants could pre-register to the event through EDRA's website.

4. Realisation

The Multiplier event was realised on 22nd March 2022 with 28 participants. Almost all participants had registered, finally came to the event. After the completion of the registration, the event started with the presentation of the host organisation KSDEO "EDRA" by the Communications Officer of the European Projects Department, Katerina Samartzi. Then, Maria Kosma the project manager of "Restoring Respect Project" made a presentation of the project and its aims and outputs. The presentation focused especially on the e-course in order for the participants to get familiar with the format and the simple to use structure of the platform as well with the app. After this, Maria Kosma presented the research about migration in Greece that was realized in the framework of the IO1 of the "Restoring Respect Project". Finally, the psychologist and researcher, Michail Skaltsas made a presentation about the good practices for the integration of migrants in a European context. Michail, has worked for a long time with migrants and refugees and he also shared with the audience some examples of the good practices he has used during his work in migrants and refugees inclusion. Then, the participants had the chance to discuss with the presenters about their concerns, questions and the general situation in Greece today regarding the migration issue. The audience was really interested in the issue and the discussion was participatory and many opinions were heard.

The event realized with 28 participants. The majority of the participants have a social background as they are psychologists, social workers who work with migrants, social


scientists and psychology students. Moreover, two art therapists attended the event and some people who were interested in the migration inclusion.









