1. Objectives of the event

Under the title "The integration of migrants and refugees in Europe: a common challenge for all of us that will shape the future of a more social Europe", Altius carried out a practical and interactive workshop in two sessions with mixed groups from Ecuador, Colombia, Perú, Dominican Republic, Venezuela and Morocco.

Main features and objectives:

- > to present the RRP project to migrant young people and trainers in Madrid
- > to disseminate the intellectual outputs of the project at local level using Spanish, but also key languages spoken by the participating migrants and refugees
- > to support the project transferability and replication strategy by delivering the results of the project and showing 'what works'
- > to engage potential new stakeholders, funders and users of the platform, programme and tools
- beyond the life of the project and raise awareness
- ➤ to be delivered in a user-led fashion showcasing in practice to relevant stakeholders the power of user led project delivery and allowing the voices of local migrants to be heard directly by policy makers and the public and thus restore respect.

3. Organisation

The event targeted young migrants and refugees, and stakeholders as VET providers, academics, researchers, local policy-makers, and civil society organisations. It was disseminated through the Altius Foundation communication channels, through the University Francisco de Vitoria network, Europe Direct network at national level, and the CEPI centres network at regional level (Community of Madrid).

After announcing the event, all interested people and organisations contacted the CEPI centre of Altius Foundation. The coordinator of the Centre of migrants' participation and integration collected a list of interested users in participating at the workshop. The participation was limited to 25 people, but finally 27 were accepted and assisted to the event.

The event took place at the Altius Foundation head offices in Madrid on March 15th, 2022. The Altius Foundation headquarter disposes of lounge fully equipped with 50 tables and chairs, 40 computers, internet access, WIFI, overhead projector, stereo mini projector. It is an accessible location not only for those with physical and visual disabilities, but it's a place where young migrants and refugees can easily access and trust in the offered activities.

The event was also promoted through 2 flyers - digital and print versions - that were distributed to the target groups a month before the event takes place.

4. Realisation

On 15th March all participants were received by the RRP project coordinator Ms. Clara Ubeda at the headquarters of Altius Foundation in Madrid. After short presentation of the project, the workshop continued combining presentations from the team with interactive activities – using the developed outputs, visiting the on-line course; networking sessions and a final plenary session. An evaluation sheet was distributed to all participants to collect their feedback.

5. Participants

In the event were involved 27 participants, mainly young people 20-25 years old, unemployed, migrants, third country nationals with low qualification and low digital skills.

Apart from paper questionnaire, which the participants were asked to fill in, there was performed an oral evaluation at the end of the workshop.

During it the participants expressed their opinions that products such as educational platform and mobile application are practical and useful tools to improving their competences and skills regarding to job search opportunities in Europe.

Moreover, after celebrating the event and promoting its results, Altius Foundation received requests to implement the same workshop in other CEPI migrants' centres in the Community of Madrid, and continue providing training on the developed RRP tools.
