The new office will also be referred to as "Colony E" in line with other buildings in the area that utilize an identifying letter. Behavioral Health patients will notice a large capital "E" affixed to the exterior of the building.

The Behavioral Health office was previously located at 625 N. Monte Vista in Ada.
