Dr. Jake Boone bringing orthodontics practice to The Clinic

ADA – Dr. Jake Boone is bringing his orthodontics practice to The Clinic every Thursday beginning in April 2026. He will treat Medicaid patients exclusively.

“At my core, I want to help others,” Boone said. “My goal is to create healthy, functional, and beautiful smiles. I want my patients to feel confident in themselves, and having the opportunity to be a part of that journey is an incredibly rewarding feeling.”

Boone, DDS, MS, earned his Doctor of Dental Surgery from the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry. He earned his Master of Science degree in Oral Biology from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, where he also completed his orthodontics residency.

Boone maintains an orthodontics practice in the Oklahoma City metro area as well, but will travel to Ada once a week to care for patients here. Boone was raised in Ada, where his father has maintained a successful oral surgery practice for years.

“I had fantastic healthcare providers growing up in Ada,” Boone said. “My father also had a profound impact on my life, and being around him and his practice from a young age certainly influenced my decision to pursue dentistry.”

Boone will practice at The Pharmacy at 304 N. Monte Vista in Ada, which also houses The Clinic’s dental and imaging centers. This building is just south of Mercy Hospital.

“Practicing orthodontics is like solving a puzzle,” Boone said. “It challenges me to use my mind and hands to create aesthetic and functional smiles. The blend of art and science, along with having the chance to positively impact people’s daily lives, is what makes each day meaningful for me. Also, this profession is very relationship-driven. I get to watch patients grow up and build lasting connections with them.”
