Houck moving women's health practice to new location

SEMINOLE – The Clinic is pleased to announce that women's health specialist Brooke Houck will start seeing patients at a new Seminole location effective Monday, December 11.

Houck, APRN-CNM, WHNP-BC, will see patients in her new office adjacent to The Pharmacy in Seminole at 2249 Boren Boulevard. Houck has been a provider with The Clinic since April 2023, treating patients at The Clinic's other Seminole site on Wrangler Boulevard.

Houck said she is ready to meet a rising demand for women's health needs in Seminole.

"Women accept many things in life by saying, 'Oh that's just part of getting older,' or 'This is how it's going to be,'" Houck said. "Although different body changes may occur, and be normal variations of aging, it does not mean we have to accept and live with them. My goal as a women's health provider is to help women navigate these changes."

In 2022, Houck earned a double master's degree from Georgetown University in Nursing, becoming a Certified Nurse Midwife and Women's Health Nurse Practitioner. Her undergraduate education includes earning a bachelor's degree in Nursing from Northeastern State University and, prior to that, an associate degree in Nursing from Seminole State College. She has served as a Registered Nurse in rural health care for more than 13 years.

Houck's focus as a women's health provider includes gynecological care, family planning and contraception, peri-menopausal and menopausal care, and hormone replacement therapy.
