Jennings joins team at The Women's Clinic

ADA – The Women's Clinic is pleased to announce the addition of Annika Jennings, APRN-CNP, WHNP-BC, to its team of first-class providers in Ada.

"I am so excited to be here," Jennings said. "I am joining an amazing team at The Women's Clinic. They have created a culture focused on collaboration and learning that ensures we are all providing patient-centered, up-to-date care."

Jennings is an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse, Certified Nurse Practitioner, and a Board-Certified Women's Health Nurse Practitioner. These qualifications allow her to treat a wide variety of women's health issues, in particular reproductive care.

"Examples of the care I'll provide include well woman visits, preconception care, pregnancy care, postpartum care, family planning, screenings, and perimenopausal care," she said.

Jennings earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center, where she graduated with honors. She later earned her Master of Science degree from Georgetown University, with an emphasis on Women's Health.

"I started working in the hospital as a teenager and I've worked in health care ever since," Jennings said. "My mom is a labor and delivery nurse, and I grew up idolizing her."

Before joining The Women's Clinic in Ada, Jennings practiced at SSM Health in Shawnee as well as the Oklahoma State Department of Health, where she served as a Public Health Registered Nurse. She described her new role at The Women's Clinic as her "dream job."

"I intend for my patients to feel they are receiving care that's tailored to their specific situation, and I will deliver that care in a way that makes them feel safe and heard," Jennings said.
