Jimerson flew numerous combat and rescue missions with his squadron and received the Air Force Commendation Medal for his service.

Jimerson has practiced medicine in Norman, Oklahoma, for more than 40 years. In addition to maintaining a busy practice and raising his family, Jimerson also served as chief of staff at Norman Regional Hospital for two terms, served as chairman of the OB/GYN department, and as chairman of the Emergency Room Committee.
