

The outreach committee would like to thank everyone who completed the survey and gave feedback about the feasibility of using the old fellowship center for local outreach and other church functions. There were 59 surveys returned.

After reviewing the surveys the following general conclusions were drawn.

1 There is desire by a small majority for more opportunities to serve others through our local church and some concern by others that we have too much going on already. Over all, enthusiasm for more outreach seemed cautious.

2. When considering using the old fellowship center for outreach, some were concerned about the cost to maintain another facility. Upon review of the current expenses of the fellowship center, we believe those costs could initially be around \$15,000 per year.

3 A large majority of the ideas given on the surveys for outreach opportunities could be conducted at the new fellowship center with just a few that would benefit from a designated building such as the old fellowship center.

Based on the feedback we received it seemed clear to us that there was not enough interest, or a clear need to keep the old fellowship center for purposes of local outreach ministries. It is therefore our recommendation to the church trustees to pursue other options for the old fellowship center.

As a committee we will now be focusing our attention on assessing our current outreach ministries, and developing guidance for the evaluation and implementation of ideas, as they arise.
