	Section	Explanation
1	Vision-driven leadership	Advancing educational vision and direction. A clear vision that promotes success for learners.
2	Staff development	Counselling, mentoring and team empowerment.
3	Social justice issues	Social justice issues such as social cohesion, diversity and inclusivity, teenage pregnancy, substance abuse, etc.
4	Community Relations	Strong, supportive partnerships with parents and community.
5	Establishing a stimulating environment	The establishment and maintenance of a supportive and stimulating teaching and learning environment.
6	Optimism and motivation	The way in which the candidate creates a spirit of optimism in learners and educators so that they believe they can be successful.
7	World of Work	Creating opportunities in order to equip the learners with skills and prepare them for the world of work.
8	School culture	Establishing, promoting, and maintaining a positive, inclusive, and professional school environment.
9	Progress orientation	Growth, stability, or innovation.
10	Other	Any other relevant information in support of the presentation.
