Forgiveness

All of us tend to think that faith is simply a matter of doing the right thing at the right time in the right way. We have a tendency to believe that we are right and that God loves us more than anyone else. The prayer on our lips is "look at me God I am not like those sinners over there." When we look at our lives of faith, our relationship with God, do the things we say and the things we do reflect what is truly in my heart and in my mind or have we shut God out? We may not be major league sinners but we are sinners nevertheless. We have all sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. The trouble is we don't see it. We see the sins of others all too clearly and have no problem pointing them out. However, that's not the way of a follower of Jesus, our way is to imitate the Father and do what He does and what does He do? He forgives; He kneels on the ground before us and writes His name in the barren earth which is our hearts. He reaches out to us in our need and whispers "I do not condemn you, go and sin no more." The heart of the law is mercy, and we are asked to be compassionate as our Father in Heaven is compassionate. Jesus challenges us to examine our lives, to be open and honest before him so that he can bring about healing, wholeness and peace. For Jesus there are no half measures he doesn't want anything, he wants everything, and it is only through our total self-giving that can bring about change in our lives. Each one of us must choose for or against Jesus. If I choose to follow Christ and walk the long, narrow, rugged path that he sets before me then I know that I will eventually come into a loving encounter with the one who calls us away from the dark night of sin and into the brightness of a new dawn. I will dwell in the Lord's own house where everyone is welcome, saint and sinner and no one is excluded. If I ignore Christ then he will not know me on the day of judgement. Let us pray that we may never lose sight of Jesus who leads us in our faith and who will lead us into an ever-deeper realisation of his love if only we would open our hearts to him.
