All Saints

Today the Church celebrates the Feast of All Saints and gives thanks and praise to God for all those men, women and children of faith who dedicated their lives to God wholeheartedly and without reserve and who now live with him in Heaven. The saints are not people who were in some way super human but they, like us, experienced all the trials, cares, worries of life. The saints are the most human of people because they were totally aware of their faults and failings. They knew that they weren't perfect however, they were also able to overcome these failings and by doing so show us what it means to be so totally in love with God that you are willing to give up your life for him. The saints kept their eyes fixed firmly on God and so we can look to them as examples of what it means to follow him. But today isn't just about those people whom the Church formally recognises as saints but all those throughout the world and throughout all time who sought to carry out the divine will in their lives, faithfully and lovingly. We are all called to be saints because all of us are called to holiness of life; all we have to do is live in God and allow God to live in us. If we do this, if we allow God to work in us and through us just as he did with who have gone before us, then we too will be children of God and show his love to the world. As that great Catholic writer Oscar Wilde once said: "every saint has a past and every sinner has a future". But how do we become holy? We have a clue in today's Gospel reading from the Beatitudes. The Beatitudes show us a way of life that, invites us to identify with the poor, those who mourn, the meek, and those who hunger and thirst after justice. They challenge us to be compassionate people, to be men and women who are pure in heart, and to become peacemakers in everything we do, even if it exposes us to ridicule and persecution. Today we are invited to walk the path of the saints, the way of the Beatitudes. The way is narrow and hard. We need faith and courage to walk it. The example of the saints and their prayers encourage us and help us on. So today let us give thanks and praise to God for those countless numbers of people who have lived out Gospel values in their lives, who have put God first and let us pray that we too may one day be numbered with them in Heaven.
