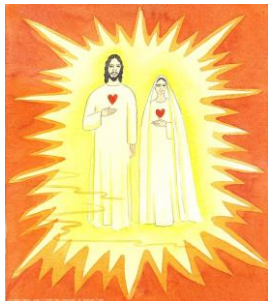
Corpus Christi
