For the walkers

St John Kemble Deanery Walk **Sunday 12th April**. A walk on Hergest Ridge is planned for Sunday 12th April. Hergest Ridge rises above the market town of Kington. It straddles the English Welsh border and covers a section of the Offa's Dyke long distance footpath. The walk up to the trig point and back is approximately 4.5 miles/ 2 hours long. The first part is a long but gentle incline up the grassy broad ridge. There are no stiles and the walk is easy if taken slowly. The views across Powys, Herefordshire and beyond are stunning. Meet ready to start walking at 2 pm at the gate on to the open hillside at the top of Ridgebourne Road. Directions: Head for Hergest Croft Gardens (HR5 3EG) There is a free car park on Ridgebourne Road opposite the entrance to the gardens. Please share lifts where possible to avoid congestion.
