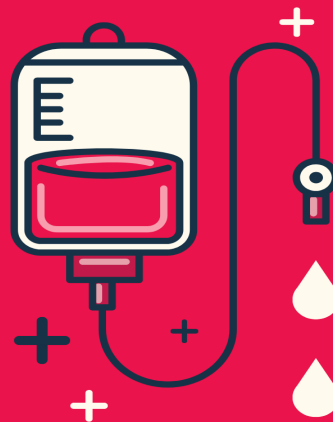
Franciscan Health Michigan City is seeking dependable and friendly volunteers!

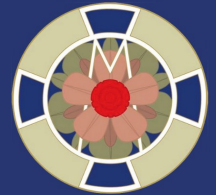

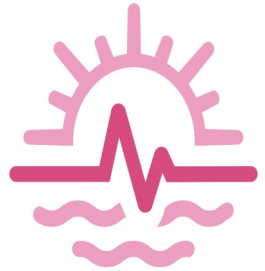

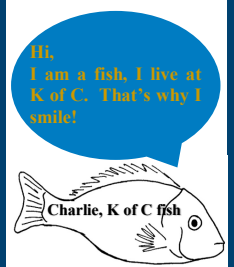
