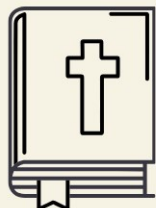

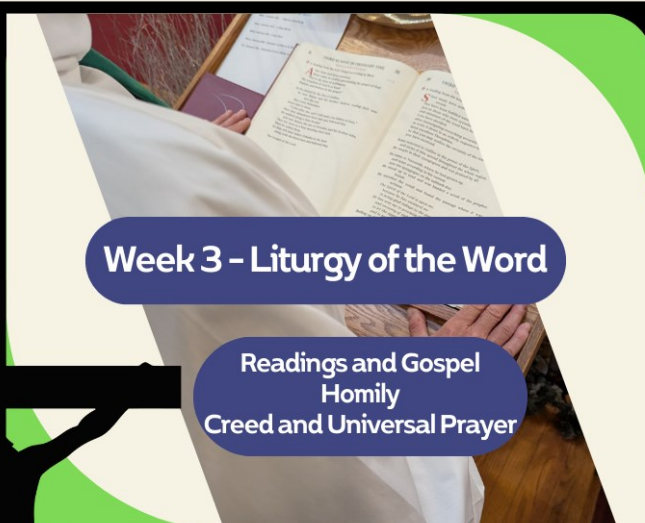

## Catechesis on the Mass

CCC 1324 - The **Eucharist** is "the **source** and **summit** of the Christian life."

Sacrosanctum Concilium 14 (Vatican II):

Mother Church earnestly desires that all the faithful should be led to **full, conscious, and active participation** in liturgical celebrations which is demanded by the very nature of the liturgy, and to which the Christian people, "a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a redeemed people," have a **right and an obligation by means of their Baptism**.

Pope Pius X on Participation:

*"The faithful must take part in the liturgy **not as strangers or silent spectators, but penetrated with its beauty.**"*

Sacrosanctum Concilium 36 (Vatican II):

*"The use of the **Latin language** is to be preserved in the Latin rites."*

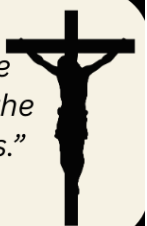

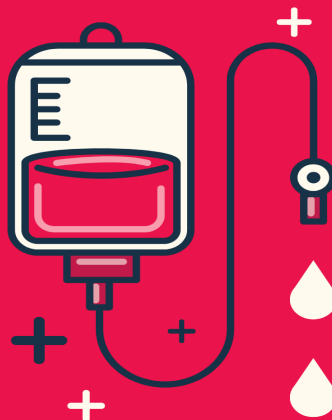

Households assisted: 108 Individuals assisted: 307

Sacred Heart Food Pantry—A summary for 2025:

For 2025 we had a total of 250 households registered, consisting of 559 adults and children (12 and under) 116. Our food expenses totaled \$29,295.24, and our personal care totaled \$4,734.66. All of this is possible because the Parishioners of Holy Family Parish make it possible. Thank you to all who donate through the Sunday collections, fund raisers (Knights of Columbus, Unique Chance, Butterfly Hospitality), recycling efforts, food drives (November Brown Bag and the 40 days of Lent), Kroger's rewards and just because you wanted to contribute. On behalf of all of those we serve at our pantry, we thank you.
