Catechesis on the Mass

CCC 1157: **Song** and **music** fulfill their function as signs...according to three principal criteria:

- (1) **beauty** expressive of prayer,
- (2) the **unanimous participation** of the assembly at the designated moments,
- (3) and the **solemn character** of the celebration.

In this way they participate in the purpose of the liturgical words and actions: the glory of God and the sanctification of the faithful.

Cardinal Robert Sarah on Silence:

*It is impossible to enter into the mystery of God without entering into the **solitude** and **silence** of our interior desert*

CCC 1430 paraphrased:

Jesus calls all to a conversion of the heart. This interior conversion finds expression through **visible signs, gestures**, and **works of penance**.

Pope Pius XII on Recognizing Sin in the Mass:

*Perhaps **the greatest sin** in the world today is that men have begun to **lose the sense of sin**.*






