# Letter from the Pastor

Dear Friends,

Many of you have already asked or may be asking the following questions surrounding the upcoming transition. Please see my answers below:

Where is Fr. Nate moving?

- St. Paul Parish, Valparaiso
- Mailing Address: P.O. Box 1475, Valparaiso, IN 46384

Is Fr. Nate taking Holy Family staff with him to St. Paul?

- Out of respect for the incoming pastor, priests do not usually "take" staff members with them to a new parish. It is my intention to ensure a smooth transition for Fr. Roque by leaving him a robust team to assist him in ministry. Similarly, the parish I am moving to already has a staff ready to begin working with me upon my arrival. At the same time, each employee of any given parish has the autonomy to determine their own future employment decisions.

Is Fr. Roque keeping current staff members at Holy Family Parish?

- Again, typically a new pastor will work with the staff that he inherits and discern the appropriate path moving forward. Sometimes structural changes are necessary, but ordinarily changes are relatively slow and measured in parish life.

Will parish policies and protocols change with the new pastor?

- All parish policies remain in effect, unless and until a new pastor decides otherwise.

Will the parish continue progress on current and upcoming projects?

- There are several projects that are ongoing and will continue under Fr. Roque:
  - The sale of 128 Bach Street to the City of LaPorte for the development of affordable housing
  - The building of a new storage garage at the Sacred Heart campus, to replace garages that will be demolished
  - The reconstruction of the Marian grotto at the Sacred Heart campus
  - The continued restoration of the stone facade on the St. Joseph church and rectory.
  - Security upgrades to the St. Joseph school building
  - Other ongoing projects

Is Holy Family still exploring opening a school?

- As was shared in the results of our 2025 feasibility study, a full renovation of the Faith Formation Center (St. Joseph school building) is currently infeasible, due to our parish's inability to raise the needed funds. This limitation, along with the significant administrative costs of starting up a school, means this project is no longer a priority of the parish. If new opportunities present themselves in the future, Fr. Roque may revisit this possibility as he sees fit. At the same time, we are currently upgrading the St. Joseph building to provide bolstered security for our Faith Formation students.

Will Fr. Nate be allowed to come back to celebrate my funeral or wedding?

- St. Paul is a parish of roughly 3,000 registered families, much larger than Holy Family. Because of this and my duties as vocation director, I will have significantly greater demands in my new position, limiting my ability to attend outside functions. Therefore, all future weddings, funerals, and other events are entrusted to Fr. Roque and Fr. Alex, because they will be your priests. If I happen to be available for a wedding or funeral that does not conflict with my needs at St. Paul, I may possibly be able to celebrate alongside your priests.

Am I allowed to register at St. Paul and attend Mass there regularly?

- While everyone is allowed to make their own decisions, I would highly encourage you to remain where you are. After all, according to Church law, you must live within or near the geographic boundary of a parish in order to register as a parishioner. Please support Fr. Roque as he arrives in LaPorte and work with him to carry on the mission of the parish, because Holy Family is your home. Of course, you are more than welcome to visit me occasionally.

I am grateful for your patience and understanding in this time of transition.

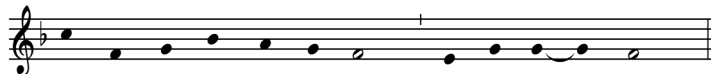

# The Fr. Kouris Korner

## WHY MARY IN MAY?

Welcome to *The Kouris Korner*, a Bulletin Article page written by Fr. Alex Kouris. In this part of the bulletin, I hope to be able to write on topics regarding our faith, our culture, and our world. Some may be on a series like the documents of the Church, the Sacraments, Spiritual Readings, My random thoughts that seem interesting to me, or whatever seems appropriate to share regarding our current situation in the good ol' city of LaPorte, IN.

We are now in the month of May and Spring is in full force: the grass is greener than ever before with all this rain we've been getting, the weather is warmer and flowers are blooming. Speaking of flowers, May is the Month of Mary in the Church and Catholics at this time crown our Blessed Mother with flowers in what is known as May Crowning. Why exactly do we honor Mary this month and what is it with May Crowning?

In ancient cultures, May was devoted to certain deities of fertility or blooming since it coincided with the full swing of Spring and the end to Winter. When Christianity became the recognized religion of the West (especially in Medieval times), Catholics devoted a 30-day period to honor Mary at times throughout the year. Some traditions still follow a 30-day period known as "Lady Month" from August 15 - September 14. Eventually in the 19th century, May became most associated with her since she is the Mother of God and her Yes was the blooming of the Flower of Salvation, Christ our Savior in her womb.

There are also three feast days that are dedicated to Mary during May. First is May 13th, the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, when Our Mother visited three shepherd children in 1917 and asked them to pray the Rosary every day for peace in the world. Second is May 25th, the Memorial of Mary, the Mother of the Church, which takes place a day after Pentecost Sunday commemorating Mary's new role after she received the Holy Spirit to be the Mother of the whole Church. Finally, May 31st we celebrate the Feast of the Visitation,

where Mary went in haste with the Child Jesus to St. Elizabeth, her cousin who was pregnant with St. John the Baptist. Unfortunately with 2026, The Visitation falls on Trinity Sunday, meaning it is overshadowed by the feast celebrating the Triune God. Nonetheless, we can still make provisions to celebrate both on the same day in your own private devotion!



Catholics during this month practice the devotion of crowning Mary with flowers at their Churches or in their homes. While we do not have a formal May Crowning at Holy Family, this is something you can do at home! This can be done at any point of the month of May, whether be on one of the upcoming feast days or even today since May 10th is Mothers day! Gather the family around a statue of Mary that you have and make a flower crown to place it on her head (or placing flowers in a vase before a picture image can also work if you do not have a statue). Say the Rosary with your family, a prayer for honoring her and asking for protection, or singing a Marian hymn you know from Mass.



Because Mary is the Mother of all Christians, we ought to honor her along with our earthly mothers. She nurtures and cares for all her children and loves whenever we spend time with her by meditating on the Holy Rosary. As you spend time honoring your mother today in whatever tradition, consider honoring your heavenly Mother who is always with you. May all the mothers in our parish be blessed this day and may you continue to devote yourself as a little child to the Queen of Heaven, the Star of the Sea, the Mother of all Christians and of the Church.

## CASH

Cash is one of the easiest ways to make a charitable contribution. A cash contribution can be a check, money order or cashier's check.

## SECURITIES

A gift of securities may be given so that the donor receives a tax deduction equal to the fair market value of the donated assets while avoiding capital gains tax on the donated assets. Holy Family Parish will work with you to facilitate the donation of both marketable and closely held securities.

## LIFE INSURANCE

Life insurance is an easy way to make a significant contribution. You may give a policy that is no longer needed, take out a new policy, or name the Holy Family Parish as a beneficiary of an existing policy. Direct the proceeds, cash value of policy, or any portion of it to benefit your parish.

## BEQUEST

By instructing a bequest in your will, you can specify an amount or percentage from your estate naming Holy Family Parish as a permanent beneficiary.

## IRA CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION

Using a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a tax-savvy strategy that allows you to transfer up to \$100,000 per year from your IRA directly to a qualified organization, such as Holy Family Parish. It is only available to IRAs and individuals who have reached a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) age, currently 73 years old. Any amount processed as a QCD counts toward your RMD requirement and reduces the taxable amount of your IRA distribution. This lowers both your adjusted gross income and taxable income, resulting in a lower overall tax liability.

## MEMORIAL GIFTS

Making a donation in memory of someone special reflects your desire to make a lasting impact on the lives of others, just as your honoree has done. You may also include the desire for memorial gifts to be made in your name as part of your final plans. You may choose to designate memorial gifts for a particular purpose of your choice at Holy Family.

## RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS

Holy Family Parish may be designated as the beneficiary under a donor's qualified retirement plan benefits, including IRAs, 401(k)s, 403(b)s, and Keogh (HR-10) plans. Retirement benefits may be the most tax-efficient way to make a gift to the parish.
