
Fiat Fitness Sat. June 28

May Food Expenses: \$1,779.47 Personal Care: \$199.75 Households assisted: 91 Individuals assisted: 229 Our pantry was included in the Post Office Food Drive held May 10th. We received 55 totes of non-perishable foods which helped us keep our costs for May down. We are so grateful to our generous parishioners who continue to donate food/money to keep us

going and allow us to provide for those in need in our community.


