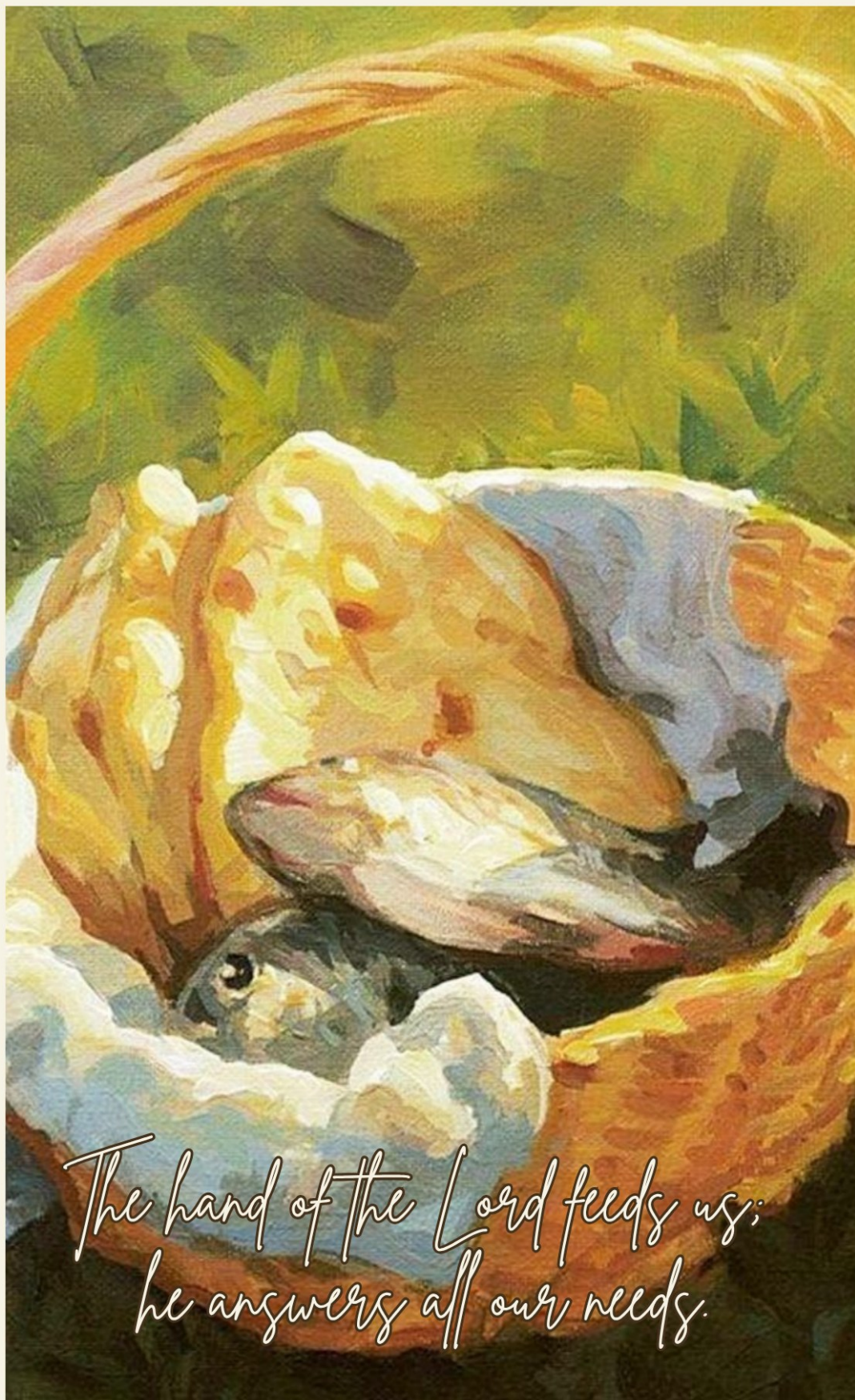

FOR THE FATHER

Earlier in July, I had the privilege of attending the yearly **Encounter Conference** in Grand Rapids, MI. Encounter Ministries is an apostolate that aims to equip the clergy and lay faithful with tools for evangelization. They offer classes online or in person to experience and encounter the Lord Jesus and be able to share him with others in our day-to-day lives. I've known about Encounter for some time now and finally made the commitment to go with two of my priest friends to the conference.

What a beautiful time. Almost six-thousand Catholics (and some protestants!) were in attendance to experience the Lord in their identity, in prophecy, in healing, and in empowerment. Encounter makes use of the Charismatic gifts that St. Paul refers about (1 Cor 12:1-11) for active ministry and how our Faith life and journey is to be similar to those amazing stories we read in the Acts of the Apostles.



I saw many people receive the Holy Spirit in profound ways: tears, joy, and falling down and resting in Him. At the healing service, there were people lined up for an hour to tell everyone about their testimony and how the Lord miraculously healed them of their physical injuries.

Not only that, but the amount of people who engaged in prayer over others was incredible. It was not just the "experts" asking for healing, or a word of prophecy, or anything else. Normal people like you and I were achieving the mighty acts of God just by being open and trusting in faith.

While I did not receive a lot of graces like the miracle of healing, the Father gave me his blessing once more of identity, showing me how much He delights in me and that reminds me how important that is in my life.

All of this is for God and his Glory. He gives what is sufficient rather than what is wanted and if we accept that, that is all we need in this world, even if we are burdened with great sickness or injury. The Joy of being a Father's son is something I want to go back to so much because it is that needed in my life.



A further grace then was when I came to the day of **Spiritual Brewings**, my classes on prayer and Ignatian Spirituality. The night before, I felt such intense joy setting things up all the way until midnight because at the 7:00 PM Spanish mass on Wednesday, I heard the Father tell me, after a long and tiring day where my Spanish was barely holding on, how thankful he was that I was pouring myself out for Him.



The next day, I was shocked to see that almost 100 people in total were in attendance for both morning and evening classes. I was overwhelmed with joy at the sight of those who attended the first classes, not because I had a successful event, but rather how much people yearn to have a relationship with the Father; how much people desire how to pray!

The people of LaPorte are hungry for life in God and that fills my heart with joy because what I have experienced from the Father, people want the same. I am a firm believer of the "**infectious joy**" method of sharing the Gospel. That if we are living life in the Spirit, free in the Lord, and loved by the Father, who wouldn't want that? People see Christians being happy because they know they are loved by the Father and for all things they do for the Father. There is nothing in this life worth more than knowing and living in our identity as sons and daughters of our heavenly Father.

WAYS TO GIVE

HELP US TO MEET OUR CSA GOAL IN THE FOLLOWING WAYS:

CASH

Cash is one of the easiest ways to make a charitable contribution. A cash contribution can be a check, money order or cashier's check.

SECURITIES

A gift of securities may be given so that the donor receives a tax deduction equal to the fair market value of the donated assets while avoiding capital gains tax on the donated assets. Holy Family Parish will work with you to facilitate the donation of both marketable and closely held securities.

LIFE INSURANCE

Life insurance is an easy way to make a significant contribution. You may give a policy that is no longer needed, take out a new policy, or name the Holy Family Parish as a beneficiary of an existing policy. Direct the proceeds, cash value of policy, or any portion of it to benefit your parish.

BEQUEST

By instructing a bequest in your will, you can specify an amount or percentage from your estate naming Holy Family Parish as a permanent beneficiary.

IRA CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION

Using a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a tax-savvy strategy that allows you to transfer up to \$100,000 per year from your IRA directly to a qualified organization, such as Holy Family Parish. It is only available to IRAs and individuals who have reached a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) age, currently 73 years old. Any amount processed as a QCD counts toward your RMD requirement and reduces the taxable amount of your IRA distribution. This lowers both your adjusted gross income and taxable income, resulting in a lower overall tax liability.

MEMORIAL GIFTS

Making a donation in memory of someone special reflects your desire to make a lasting impact on the lives of others, just as your honoree has done. You may also include the desire for memorial gifts to be made in your name as part of your final plans. You may choose to designate memorial gifts for a particular purpose of your choice at Holy Family.

RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS

Holy Family Parish may be designated as the beneficiary under a donor's qualified retirement plan benefits, including IRAs, 401(k)s, 403(b)s, and Keogh (HR-10) plans. Retirement benefits may be the most tax-efficient way to make a gift to the parish.

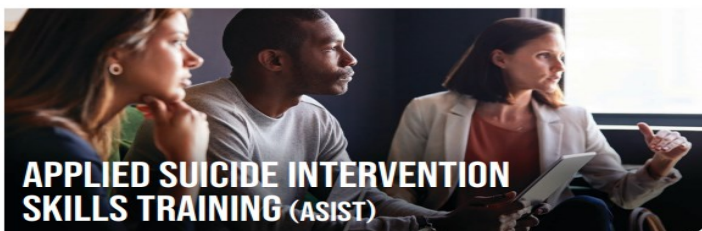

APPLIED SUICIDE INTERVENTION SKILLS TRAINING (ASIST)

What Does ASIST Offer?

LivingWorks ASIST is a two-day, two-trainer, workshop designed for members of all caregiving groups. Family, friends, and other community members may be the first to talk with a person at risk, but have little or no training.

ASIST can also provide those in formal helping roles with professional development to ensure that they are prepared to provide suicide first aid help as part of the care they provide.

The emphasis is on teaching suicide first aid to help a person at risk stay safe and seek further help as needed. Participants learn to use a suicide intervention model to identify persons with thoughts of suicide, seek a shared understanding of reasons for dying and living, develop a

safe plan based upon a review of risk, be prepared to do follow-up, and become involved in suicide-safer community networks. The learning process is based on adult learning principles and highly participatory. Graduated skills development occurs through mini-lectures, facilitated discussions, group simulations, and role plays.

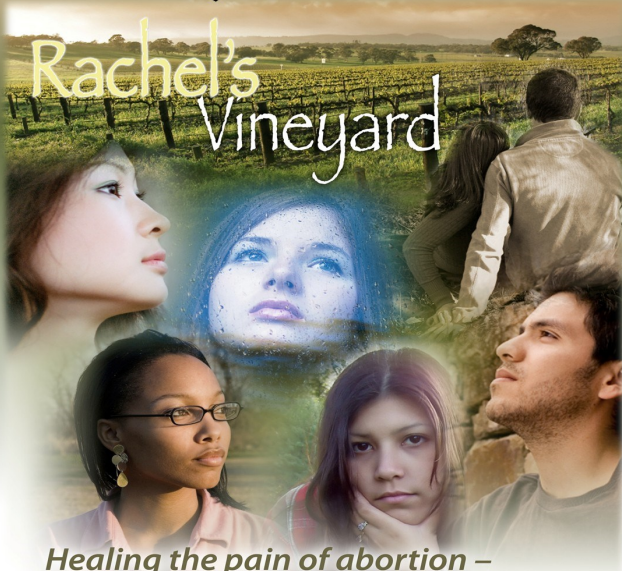

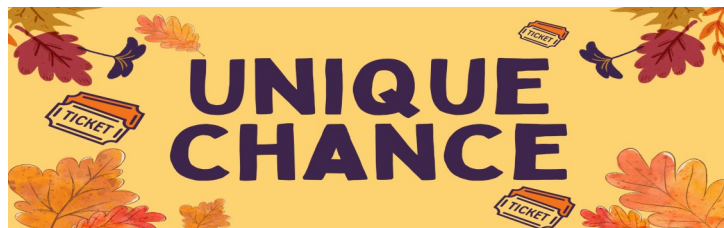
