SCHOOL

"Ding-Dong-Ding-Dong.....Ding-Dong-Ding-Dong...Ding-Dong-Ding-Dong....Ding-Dong-Ding-Dong....."

...I hear from the bells of St. Peters on the hour. I remember the same bells from my college days at Marian University reminding me how close I am to the next class time or deadline for an assignment. The school life is one I do miss from time to time. For the last 10 years before ordination, I was in higher education: four years at Marian University for my bachelors in Psychology, a year off, two years at Immaculate Heart of Mary College Seminary for Philosophy, and then four years at Sacred Heart Major Seminary for Theology.

I look back at those days with a sense of joy as the school year is heading into its first completed month. Sure, there were plenty of times of stressing out over exams and late night papers, but the connections I had, the lessons I learned humanly or intellectually, and certain experiences really made a difference in my life.



As the Chaplain for Marquette High School now, I step back into the halls of a busy school life. Students are at the move when the bell tolls as they shuffle to their next class, to lunch, or to go home. When I was there for the Freshman retreat, it was a neat experience for me as I got to see the campus life in and out of the classroom.

One of the interesting things about me and this assignment that Bishop McClory chose for me, is that I was a homeschooler all throughout my early education. The only time I ever set foot in an active high school as a teenager was when I had to take the SAT at Crown Point's High School. The amount of teenagers my age was honestly overwhelming but I was fascinated by something I never got to experience in my twelve years of homeschooling. College was the first opportunity I had to experience socializing with other students.

I had friends in homeschool sure, but we never got to bond over the stress of test-taking or complain about homework. So Marquette is a rather alien experience to me. I am grateful though for this assignment for me to learn.



Despite being out of school officially for the foreseeable future, I still appreciate the value of learning in my life. I honestly loved my Psychology and Theology studies. It was so interesting to obtain a new perspective on things in this world, physically and spiritually. Now as an associate Pastor, I felt that my time learning has slowed down drastically.

One thing our formators tell us in the seminary is the importance of ongoing study and formation. It is up to us to remain sharp theologically through the continuation of our own private education. Reading does not stop when you graduate much to some people's surprise. Otherwise, we continue to rely on the information we received these past years. It is helpful as I have been surprised by how much I know about our Faith. At the same time, I know my weaknesses or areas that I need to study more.

A lot of us could do better with learning more about the faith and expand our capacity for knowledge. **A good way to do this is to pick something you really enjoy or want to learn about.** Some find Church history to be very interesting, or to study the writings of their favorite saint. Others may be intellectually stimulated by high theological topics like the Trinity, Angelology/Demonology, or the Hypostatic Union of Christ.

If nothing else, have you read the **Catechism of the Catholic Church**? It is an amazing document that encapsulates the fullness of our teachings in a manner that reads easily. Make it a goal for yourself this year to learn one new aspect, teaching, or topic in our faith. You'd be surprised by what you learn!
