

In the <u>year 325 A.D</u>. the Church's leaders met to discuss serious issues surrounding Christian beliefs, and what they left us is the creed we recite every Sunday and solemnity. and love the character of Matthew.


Most of us know that Matthew wrote the first Gospel which appears in the New Testament of the Bible.







