





#### PREACHING SERIES:

"Remembering NICAEA: What we believe".

This year, 2025 is a special year not only because it is a Jubilee Year (celebrated every 25 years). We also mark the **1700th anniversary** of the Council of Nicaea — the first of the Church's ecumenical councils — which gave us the Nicene Creed. In the year 325 A.D. the Church's leader met to discuss serious issues surrounding Christian beliefs, and what they us is the creed we recite every Sunday and solemnity. This is the final week of our eight (8) week preaching series at Sunday Mass on the Nicene Creed.

WEEK 8 Christ the King Sunday - "He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and His Kingdom will have no end..."

- 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary Why was this feast day instituted?
- What is Jesus' role as judge of the living and dead?
- What does it mean for Christ to rule over one's life?






