Finance and Facilities – Margaret Bearden

- The Budget is doing well year to date. Pledges are ahead of schedule.
- Budget owners will receive a review of expenses. They should notify Bob of any changes or questions.

- An RFP has been developed regarding a new dishwasher for the parish hall.
- The work has begun on the Balcony railing and the center step has been removed.
- The audit was completed with no outstanding issues.
- Stewardship is having Stewardship Sunday on September 15. They are also planning for a ministry fair (time and talent) during coffee hours. Each board should create a tri-fold to describe their ministries. Follow up from each board is very important after this ministry fair.

Outreach – Liz Halbert

- Diaper ministry continues to do well.
- CIS tutoring (organized by Alice Kennedy) ends next week.
- Brunswick partnership for Housing (BPH) has graduated 2 families and will have a fundraiser on May 21.
- Belize Ministry has been renamed to St. Philip's International Mission – Belize
- Chapel Docents plan to have the Chapel of the Cross open the entire week of July 4th.
- SOIFF is having a National Day of Prayer. They are also organizing a “Day for Hope” on August 10 at the Moose Lodge. This event needs volunteers as they are getting organized. It is directed at K – 8 students getting ready for school.
- The idea of participating in Meals on Wheels 1 Saturday per month (similar to St. Peter Lutheran) was discussed. Lots of research and planning is needed. The plan is to have board chairs mention it at their meetings and start developing a level of interest.
