- Altar Guild reports that all is good for the supply of ashes needed for Ash Wed services. They will be ordering palms soon. Fr Eric asked about ordering a new Paschal candle.
- Flower Guild says that there continues to be delivery challenges by supplier. There were three Sundays in Jan. where none were delivered, and flowers had to be purchased from local stores. The warehouse manager said he would oversee our deliveries going forward.
- Request letters have been sent to clergy for summer services at Oak Island. Fr Bill Pickering, Fr Bill Eberle and Mthr Mary Curtis have agreed to serve. Fr Reggie will serve on Labor Day weekend. The letter requesting permission to use Register Park has been submitted to Oak Island Rec Dept. An order has been placed for new crosses to hand out at services.
- The Red Cross class on March 1st from 9-12:30PM is currently full with 24 people attending, and a waitlist has been created. There will be two trainers who will be teaching CPR, AED, and basic First Aid. Three incidents during services have occurred since Christmas. Instructions are “when in doubt, call 911”. Two members of our church have agreed to attend Wed noon services in the Chapel as part of our safety and security team.
