Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) Power Camp will be here soon, and we are beginning the application process for Huddle Leaders and Junior Huddle Leaders. This year's Power Camp is 6/15/26 - 6/19/26 at Fredericksburg Christian Lower School.

June sounds so far away, but planning is well on its way and the application process for Huddle Leaders/Junior Huddles is now open.

Applicants must be 13, (by 6/15/26) or older to serve as a Huddle Leader/Junior Huddle Leader.

Our prayer as we work with venues that will host our camp, including our off campus locations, is to ensure we can offer a healthy environment at Power Camp – physically, mentally, emotionally, and spiritually.

Application Process is as follows:

Please prayerfully consider this Call to be a servant at Power Camp. We are looking for athletes who demonstrate that they want to be leaders by:

Completing your own application: Applications that are completed by parents will not be considered.

Corresponding with FCA Leadership: When filling out an application as a Leader, we ask that any questions/concerns be asked by you and not your parents. Contact from parents of applicant is appropriate; but, as a leader, we want you to show initiative and leadership by contacting Coach Brock (Huddle Leader Coordinator) directly: uth4hym@comcast.net or (540) 538-7144. All communication from Coach Brock during the application process is via email and/or text, so please check those accounts regularly.

Upon submission and review of the Application and Reference Letter, a personal interview with a Huddle Leader Coordinator will be scheduled for all applicants. Date and time of interview will be scheduled in the beginning of April by email and/or text.

Each year we have more applicants than positions available, consideration is given to those applicants who:

1. Involved in the FCA Huddle/activities at your school if available.
2. Servants: Being a Huddle Leader will likely involve having a lot of fun, but the primary reason to apply and the number one attribute Leadership is looking for is a Servant's Heart. While campers focus on having fun, Huddle Leaders **must focus on serving**.
3. Able to attend required orientation/training on 6/11/26. Details given upon selection.

4. Member of a high/middle school or travel sport's team.

Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." Mark 10: 43-45

Serving at Power Camp is a volunteer position, with many benefits:

- Your week of serving, growing, moving out of your comfort zone, and fun counts toward your High School Community Service hours (55 hours will be awarded).
- Great time of fellowship and building lasting Christian friendships with other leaders of your age. It has been proven that these friendships last a lifetime.
- The opportunity to be used by the Holy Spirit to pour into young Christian athletes (campers say that their favorite part of camp was getting to know their huddle leaders)
