Daniel got to hear a little bit of the Gospel on Saturday and we also gave him a Bible and invited him to church. He came! We were really surprised



and delighted that he came on his own to join us for worship on Sunday at TIF.

Please pray that God will work to draw Daniel to Jesus and help us to show him the love of Christ in the Gospel.

One of our relatively new Christians has been attending our men's discipleship group faithfully and God has really been helping him to grow in knowledge, faithfulness and wisdom. We've been studying what it means to live a Gospel centered life. A couple of weeks ago he asked if there was some sort of "app" that would help him keep track of all his sins so he could do a better job of keeping track of what he needed to repent of in his life.

It was a serious question and after we talked about why we don't need an app, it got us all to thinking and thanking God for his forgiveness towards us. Psalm 130:3 says, If you, Lord, kept a record of sins, Lord, who could stand?
