

## ALKMAR, HOLLAND 1429

On May 1<sup>st</sup>, 1429 Father Folkert was celebrating his first Mass in the Cathedral of St. Lawrence. Just after pronouncing the words of consecration over the wine, Father Folkert accidentally spilled the white wine in the chalice onto his chasuble, and living red Blood appeared in its place. After finishing Holy Mass, seized with panic, he cut off the border of the chasuble stained with Blood and burned it, and afterward took the part he had cut and began to mend it. After he had just finished mending the chasuble, it again was stained with Blood. The Folkert and the pastor Father Volpert Schult who also attended the Mass brought the chasuble to the Bishop of Utrech. The chasuble soaked with the Lord's Blood is kept in the Cathedral of St. Lawrence.
