

CIMBALLA, SPAIN 1370

The Eucharistic miracle took place at Cimballa in 1370 at the church of the Purification of Our Lady. The pastor of the church, Father Tomas, had been tormented for many months by doubts concerning the Real Presence of Jesus in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. During the celebration of Holy Mass one Sunday, after pronouncing the words of consecration, Father Tomas saw the Host turn into Flesh, with living Blood flowing in abundance from it, so that it spilled onto the corporal. The repentant priest began to weep out of remorse and the faithful, seeing him so upset, ran up to the altar at once and saw the miracle. The relic of the corporal stained with the Precious Blood is exposed every year on September 12 on the occasion of the anniversary of the miracle.
