

LUDBREG, CROATIA 1411

During Mass at Ludbreg in the chapel of the Count Batthyany's castle, during the consecration of the wine, a priest doubted whether the Body and Blood of Christ were really present, and the wine in the chalice turned into Blood. Not knowing what to do, the priest embedded this relic in the wall behind the main altar. The priest kept it secret and revealed it only at the time of his death. Today the relic of the miraculous Blood still draws thousand of the faithful.
