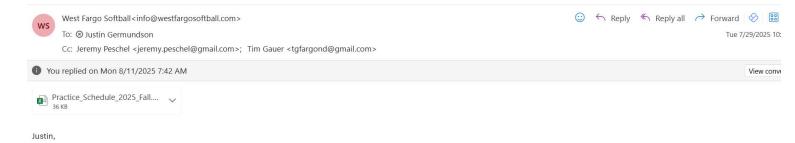

The Project consisted of local improvements for the second phase of development for River's Edge, as well as regional improvements for 78th Street S, a storm water retention system (including lift station), and a sanitary sewer lift station.

A map of this improvement district, including Assessable Areas, is printed on the reverse side of this letter.

What is the cost of the Project? How much will I be assessed for the Project?

The total City cost of the Project is \$23,286,797.53. The proposed City assessment amount for your property is \$1,046,998.57. Cass Rural Water Users District will also levy special assessments for the Project; information on those assessments will be provided by Cass Rural Water.

What are the next steps?

The Special Assessment Commission will meet on **Thursday**, **August 28**, **2025**, **at 5:30 p.m.** at the Horace Meeting House, 7961 Jacks Way, #116, Horace, ND, to hold an objection hearing regarding this improvement district. As an interested party, you may attend this hearing and voice objections to the proposed assessment.

After the Special Assessment Commission confirms the assessment list, the City Council will meet in late September or early October to take action on the special assessments; the date and location of the meeting will be published in *The Forum* and posted on the City's website. You must file a written appeal with the City Auditor prior to this meeting in order to object to the proposed assessment to the City Council.

The special assessments for the Project will be spread out over 25 years, at an interest rate of 6.40%. You may pay your special assessment without bearing any interest, if paid within ten (10) days after the special assessments have been confirmed by the City Council.
