

Mass Intention Information

The practice of requesting a Mass for loved ones is a meaningful Christian tradition. The following policies encourage parishioners and friends to schedule Masses, while also following the Canon Law of the Church:

- The Catholic Church's Canon Law assumes a standard of one intention per Mass.
- One Mass every Sunday must be scheduled for the intentions of our parishioners known as Pro Populo (For the People) as required by Canon Law.
- A Mass intention may be requested for a deceased loved one, a living person who is sick or suffering, a living person who is celebrating a birthday, anniversary or other special moment in their life, in Thanksgiving to God.
- † ALL requests MUST be scheduled through the Parish Office at least two weeks before the desired date.
- Requests will be honored on a first-come-first-serve basis in the order in which the request is received at the Parish Office.
- The suggested stipend for a Mass is \$20.00.
- Mass Intentions will be listed in the church bulletin.
