

### Mass Intention Information

The practice of requesting a Mass for loved ones is a meaningful Christian tradition. The following policies encourage parishioners and friends to schedule Masses, while also following the Canon Law of the Church:

- † The Catholic Church's Canon Law assumes a standard of one intention per Mass.
- † One Mass every Sunday must be scheduled for the intentions of our parishioners known as Pro Populo (For the People) as required by Canon Law.
- † A Mass intention may be requested for a deceased loved one, a living person who is sick or suffering, a living person who is celebrating a birthday, anniversary or other special moment in their life, in Thanksgiving to God.
- † **ALL requests MUST be scheduled through the Parish Office at least one month before the desired date.**
- † Requests will be honored on a first-come-first-serve basis in the order in which the request is received at the Parish Office.
- † The suggested stipend for a Mass is \$20.00.
- † Mass Intentions will be listed in the church bulletin.

### Información sobre intenciones de misa

La práctica de solicitar una misa por los seres queridos es una tradición cristiana muy significativa. Las siguientes normas animan a los feligreses y amigos a programar misas, respetando al mismo tiempo el Derecho Canónico de la Iglesia:

- † El Derecho Canónico de la Iglesia Católica presupone un estándar de una intención por cada misa.
- † Según lo estipulado por el Derecho Canónico, se debe programar una misa cada domingo para las intenciones de nuestros feligreses, conocida como Misa Pro Populo (Para el Pueblo).
- † Se puede solicitar una intención de misa por un ser querido fallecido, por una persona viva que está enferma o sufriendo, por una persona viva que celebra su cumpleaños, aniversario u otro momento especial en su vida, o en acción de gracias a Dios.
- † **Todas las solicitudes DEBEN programarse a través de la oficina parroquial con al menos un mes de antelación a la fecha deseada.**
- † Las solicitudes se atenderán por orden de llegada, en el mismo orden en que se reciban en la oficina parroquial.
- † La ofrenda sugerida para una misa es de \$20.00.

Demand for food assistance remains high. We are grateful to Festival Foods and Gordon Food Service. Please patronize these businesses when you plan your summer grocery shopping. We also give thanks to the parishioners who provide us each week with what we need. As food assistance programs are cut and grocery prices increase, more and more people are coming to Food Pantries for help. We serve an average of 80 households per week. Many come once a month, but some come every week if they walk or take the bus which limits what they can safely carry.

Fresh fruit and vegetables are always welcome as well as canned fruit and jars of jam. We appreciate the cash gifts and aluminum cans. Cans alone bring in approximately \$100 per month and that helps us buy more milk, eggs, chicken, and ground beef.
