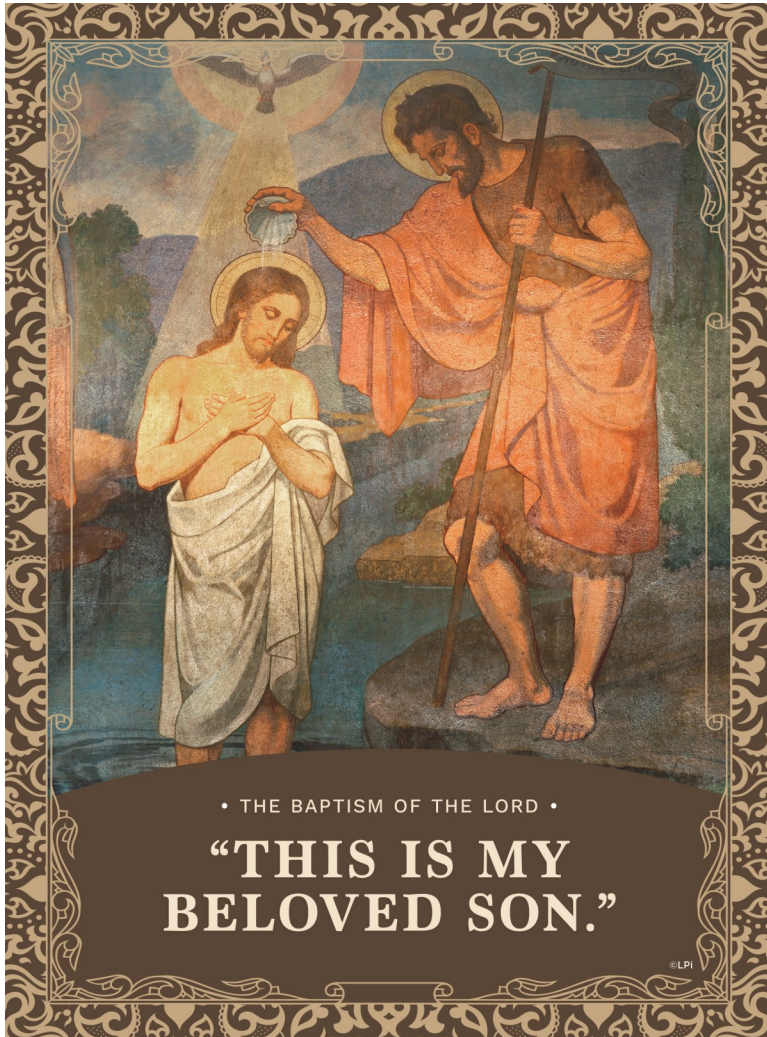

### *Understanding the Readings of Winter Ordinary Time*

Winter Ordinary Time runs from January 18, 2026 to February 15, 2026. This time is not mundane but rather a time dedicated to discipleship and living out faith in daily life. The readings during Ordinary Time often focus on Jesus' public ministry and teachings, helping us understand and follow Christ in our daily lives. Please join us on Monday, January 12, 2026 for a workshop to review the readings and explore the deeper messages being shared. There will be two sessions, the same content will be covered at each, you can pick the time that fits best with your schedule – 10:30 a.m. to Noon or 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. Snacks will be provided. There are no sign-up sheets for the workshops. Copies of the readings are at the back of church at each site, take a copy of the readings to read ahead of time. The workshops will be held at the Holy Assumption site, in the school building. Everyone is encouraged to attend to make this time extraordinary.

## A New Bible Study

Among the leaders of the early church, Barnabas may not be as well-known as the likes of Peter or Paul. However, St. Barnabas was a highly respected and influential figure in the early Christian church. Named the "son of encouragement" by the Apostles, Barnabas was known for his generosity, encouragement and support of others. A man of unwavering faith, Barnabas traveled with Paul on missionary journeys teaching and sharing the Gospel to many, encouraging believers to "remain true to the Lord with all their hearts."

### **Mass Intention Information**

The practice of requesting a Mass for loved ones is a meaningful Christian tradition. The following policies encourage parishioners and friends to schedule Masses, while also following the Canon Law of the Church:

- † The Catholic Church's Canon Law assumes a standard of one intention per Mass.
- † One Mass every Sunday must be scheduled for the intentions of our parishioners known as Pro Populo (For the People) as required by Canon Law.
- † A Mass intention may be requested for a deceased loved one, a living person who is sick or suffering, a living person who is celebrating a birthday, anniversary or other special moment in their life, in Thanksgiving to God.
- † **ALL requests MUST be scheduled through the Parish Office at least one month before the desired date.**
- † Requests will be honored on a first-come-first-serve basis in the order in which the request is received at the Parish Office.
- † The suggested stipend for a Mass is \$20.00.
- † Mass Intentions will be listed in the church bulletin.

### **Información sobre intenciones de misa**

La práctica de solicitar una misa por los seres queridos es una tradición cristiana muy significativa. Las siguientes normas animan a los feligreses y amigos a programar misas, respetando al mismo tiempo el Derecho Canónico de la Iglesia:

- † El Derecho Canónico de la Iglesia Católica presupone un estándar de una intención por cada misa.
- † Según lo estipulado por el Derecho Canónico, se debe programar una misa cada domingo para las intenciones de nuestros feligreses, conocida como Misa Pro Populo (Para el Pueblo).
- † Se puede solicitar una intención de misa por un ser querido fallecido, por una persona viva que está enferma o sufriendo, por una persona viva que celebra su cumpleaños, aniversario u otro momento especial en su vida, o en acción de gracias a Dios.
- † **Todas las solicitudes DEBEN programarse a través de la oficina parroquial con al menos un mes de antelación a la fecha deseada.**
- † Las solicitudes se atenderán por orden de llegada, en el mismo orden en que se reciban en la oficina parroquial.
- † La ofrenda sugerida para una misa es de \$20.00.
- † Las intenciones de las misas se publicarán en el boletín parroquial.
