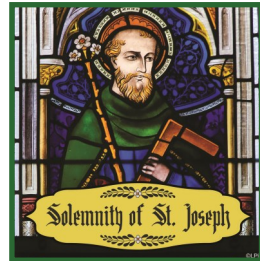

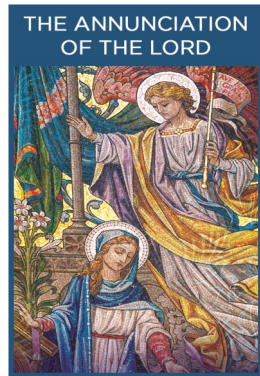
Special Weekday Masses in March

Thursday, March 19 is the *Solemnity of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary*. Mass will begin at 8:00 a.m. and will be held at the St. Augustine Site.
