### St. Vincent de Paul Quarterly Report January 1, 2026 to March 31, 2026

The St. Vincent de Paul Society Conference of St. Barnabas meets once a month on the third Wednesday at 6:30 p.m. Meetings are held at Holy Assumption grade school Room 103. All registered members of St. Barnabas are eligible to join.

The beginning balance in our treasury was \$23,091.39.

Received \$3,057.00 from church support and envelopes. SVdP also received other donations from supporters of \$1,500.00.

We disbursed \$1,708.98 in aid to those in need of financial help.

Operating expenses \$0.00 (i.e., stamps, etc.).

SVdP assisted families in need regarding one rent assistance, WE Energies \$0.00 and \$0.00 for appliances.

SVdP also provided 46 bus cards for those who needed help with transportation for medical appointments, etc.

In addition, SVdP provided 10 vouchers for our clients to shop at our SVdP stores for clothing, furniture, beds, etc. (Note: no January business.)

None of the above would have been possible without the support of the parishioners of St. Barnabas and the Parish Office staff. Together we will continue our efforts to help the needy in our community and hope and pray that our efforts will improve the spiritual and economic lives of all we encounter.
