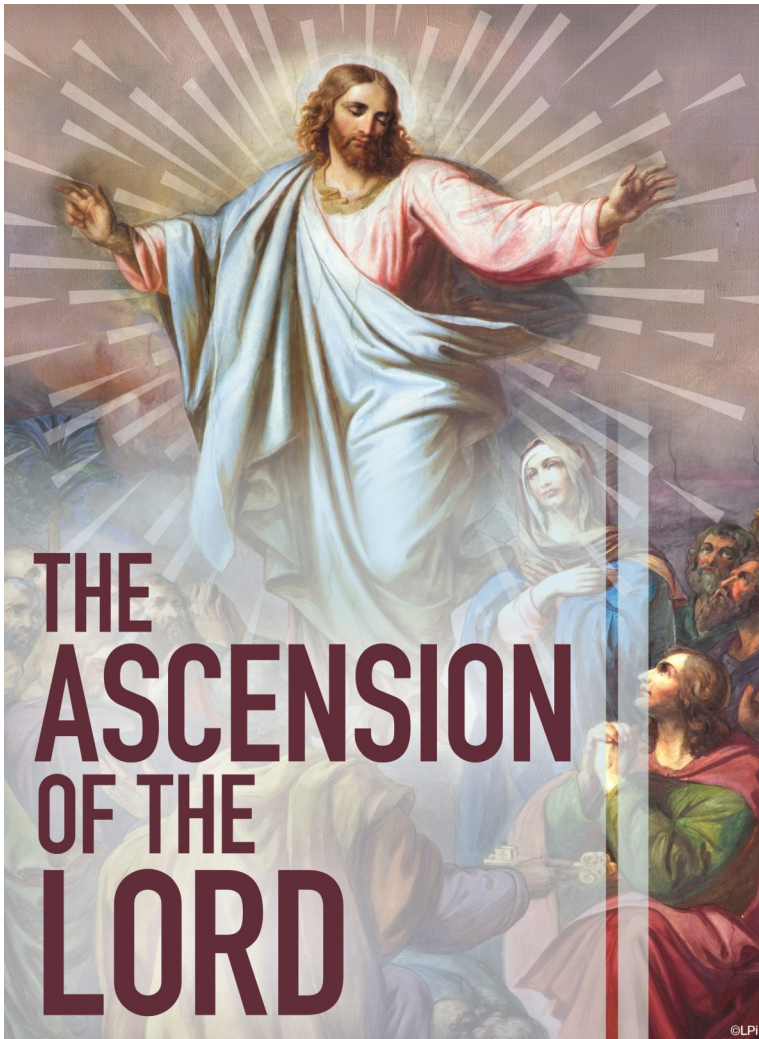

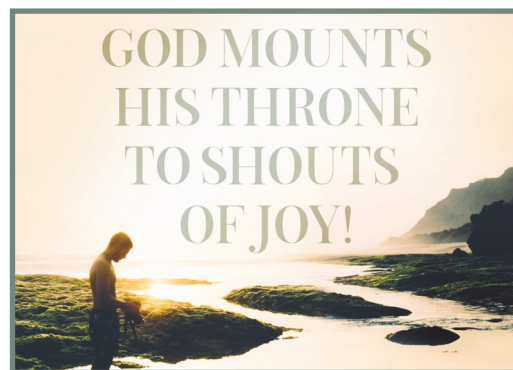

IGNITED BY THE SPIRIT:
WEAR RED ON PENTECOST

Pentecost Sunday is often called the "birthday of the Church," when the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and filled them with courage, zeal, and new life. In the Acts of the Apostles, this moment is marked by the appearance of tongues of fire--an image that has come to symbolize the presence and power of the Holy Spirit.

One simple and meaningful way we can celebrate this great feast is by wearing red to Mass on the Feast of Pentecost. Red is the liturgical color of the day, representing the fire of the Holy Spirit and the burning love of God poured into our hearts. By wearing red, we make a visible sign of our unity as a parish and our shared participation in the life of the Church.

You are invited to join in this tradition--whether it's a red shirt, tie, dress, or accessory--as we celebrate the gifts of the Holy Spirit alive among us. It's a small gesture, but one that can spark joy, conversation, and a deeper awareness of the Spirit at work in our community.

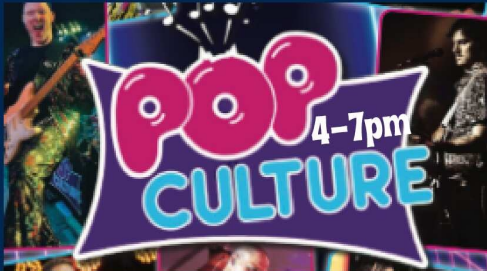

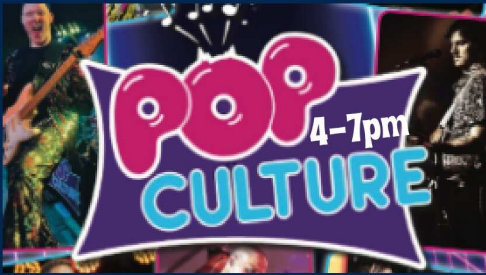
