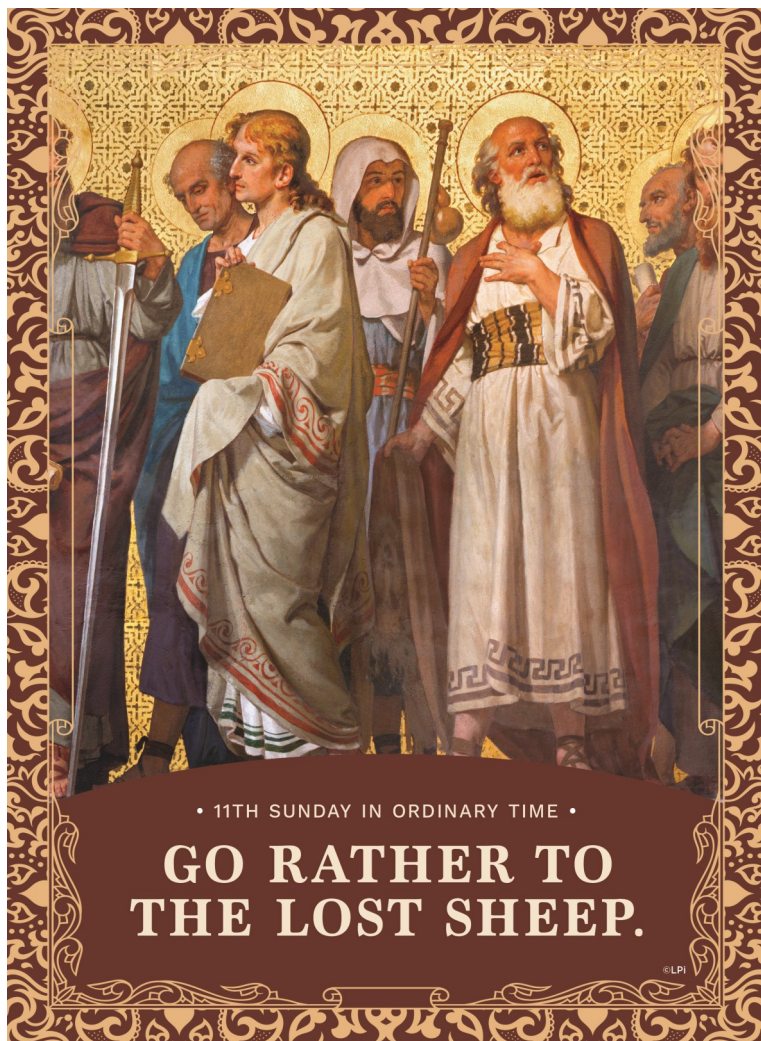

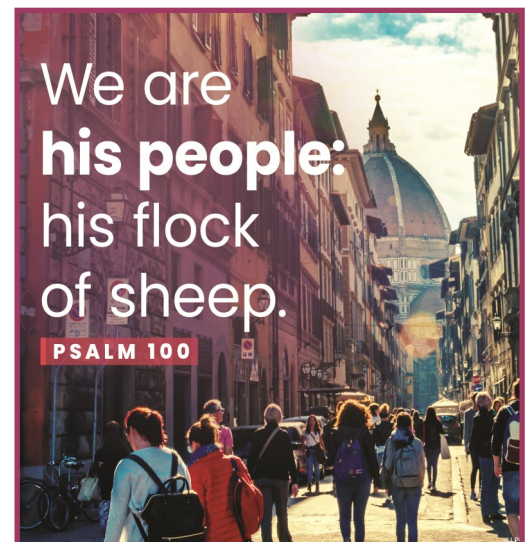

- Sealing the Envelope: To protect the contents while making the counting process easier for our volunteers, please avoid using adhesive materials like scotch tape, glue, stickers, etc. to seal the envelope. The paper flap is sufficient and much quicker for our team to open.

- For added convenience, we encourage you to consider switching your contributions to a monthly or online method. If you are interested in exploring these options or changing your current method of giving, please contact the Parish Office. We would be happy to assist you with the necessary steps.

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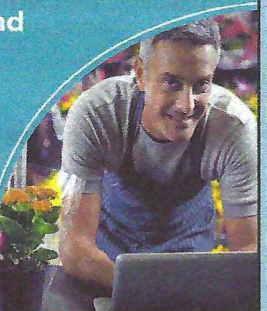
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
