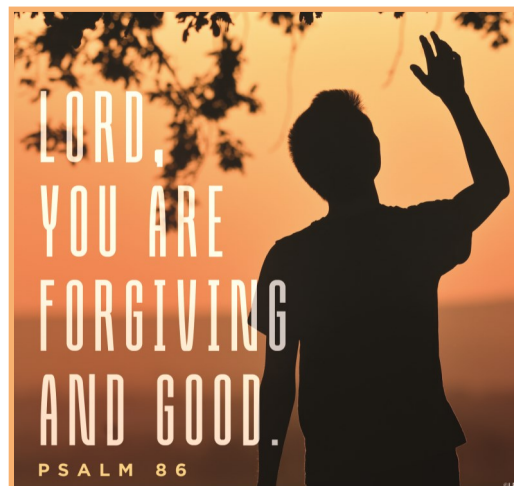

Reflection for July 2026**By Deacon Terry Starns**

Happy Belated 4th of July! We should be celebrating in a big way this year since it is our Semiquincentennial. This milestone celebrates exactly two and a half centuries since the adoption of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776. I must admit that I am not feeling as patriotic as I should since our politics are so divided. We seem to be living on the edge of one extreme fighting with the other extreme. Bipartisanship is unheard of now. But, we have endured for 250 years and I am optimistic that we may find a middle ground again some year.

Actually, celebrating the Fourth of July as a Catholic involves aligning the American pursuit of freedom with the ultimate spiritual freedom found in Christ. It means viewing patriotism not as loving our country without fault, but as exercising the Christian virtue of gratitude and striving to bring moral truth to our society.

In the Catholic tradition, freedom is not the mere ability to do whatever we want, but the power to do what we ought. St. John Paul II taught that freedom exists to help us seek and do God's will. When we celebrate "life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness", as Catholics we elevate these ideals:

- Life: The foundational right, grounded in the belief that every person is made in the image and likeness of God.
- Liberty: Freedom from the tyranny of sin and the freedom to pursue holiness.
- Happiness: The ultimate joy that comes from participating in the Kingdom of God.

As you gather with family this July, you may consider offering this prayer from the St. Francis Chapel of the St. Ignatius Province of the Oblates of the Virgin Mary:

Prayer for Our Nation

God our Father, Giver of life, we entrust the United States of America to Your loving care. You are the rock on which this nation was founded. You alone are the true source of our cherished rights to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. Reclaim this land for Your glory and dwell among Your people.

Send Your Spirit to touch the hearts of our nation's leaders. Open their minds to the great worth of human life and the responsibilities that accompany human freedom. Remind Your people that true happiness is rooted in seeking and doing Your will.

Through the intercession of Mary Immaculate, Patroness of our land, grant us the courage to reject the "culture of death." Lead us into a new era of life. We ask this through Christ our Lord.
