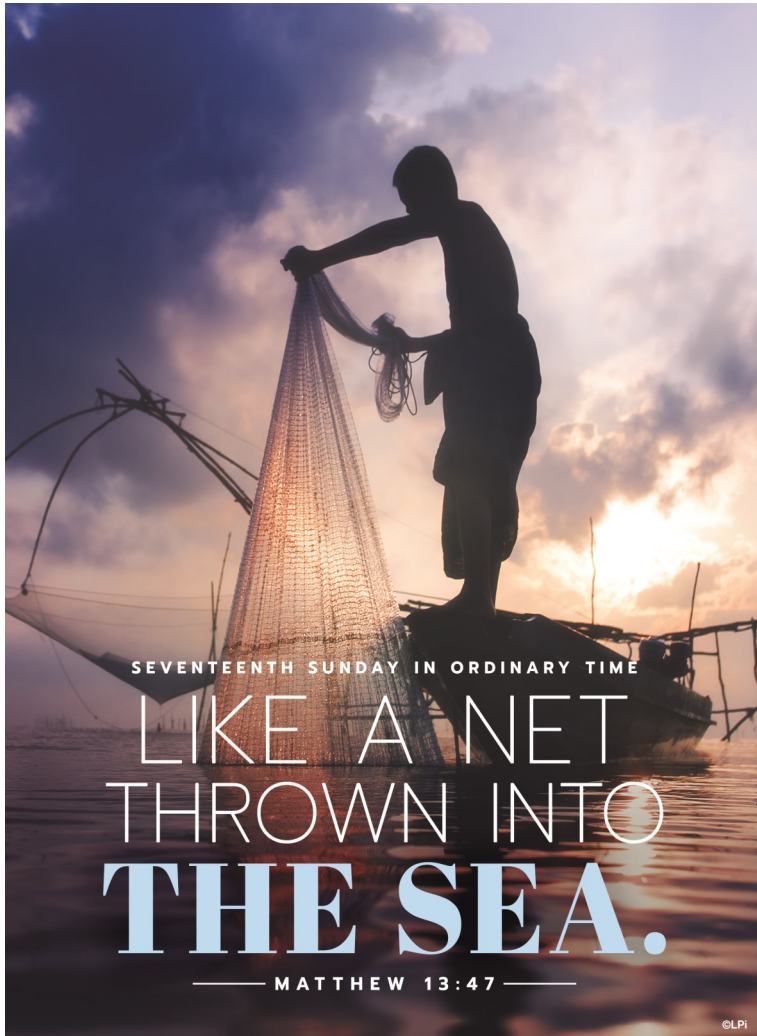

As many of you know, our parish has had two sets of pews over the years: the pews currently in the church and the original pews, which were moved to the lower level at the last renovation of the worship place.

We are grateful to everyone who shared their thoughts regarding this important decision. An overwhelming majority of our parishioners expressed a desire to bring the original pews back into the church while preserving their beautiful dark wood finish.

The original pews are crafted from solid oak and were thoughtfully designed to complement the church's architecture. Their elegant details reflect the graceful arches found in our doors and windows, helping to preserve the beauty and character of our worship space.

We are currently in the process of obtaining estimates for the restoration and reinstallation of the original pews. Once we have more information, we will share updates with the parish.

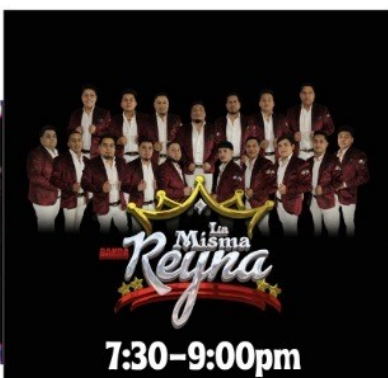
