They graciously transferred their remaining inventory to the Holy Assumption site. We are also grateful to parishioners who provide us each week with what we need. As food assistance programs are cut and grocery prices increase, more and more people will come to Food Pantries for help.

Fresh fruit and vegetables are always on our list of needs. Cash gifts and proceeds from the sale of aluminum cans are used to purchase milk, meat, and cheese.

We are currently very low on canned fruit.
