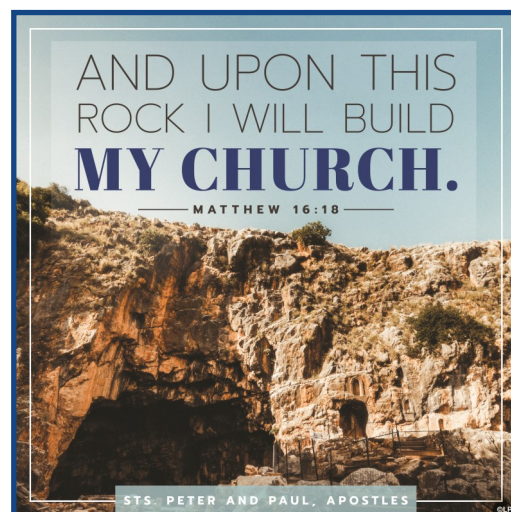

## **Pastoral Council Update**



### **Pastoral Council Achievements and New Members**

Pastoral Council, over the last year, has kept very busy! Much of what we accomplished was foundational work for the new parish, which may not be very visible to parishioners. Here is an overview of what we have accomplished since becoming Saint Barnabas Catholic Congregation:

- Formed a naming committee to recommend name options to the Archbishop (shortly before merger became official).
- Discerned the Mission, Vision, and Values for the parish.
- Led the parish branding effort, including our new logo designed by Pastoral Council member Lenore Simet.
- In complete collaboration with Dave, Maria, and Rita in the Parish Office, Pastoral Council helped to populate, review, and launch our new website.
- Worked closely with Fr. Gerardo to draft a Strategic Plan for the parish.
- Began an ongoing Ministry Governance effort to align our ministries and committees and ensure that we are all working together as one parish while continuing to serve our parish and our community.
- As part of this, we advised on the hiring of Sharon Huizenga as our new Service Coordinator to bring our service-oriented committees and ministries together.
- Council members Jeff Stanislawski and Ed Rebro were the leaders who organized the many Mission events and workshops this year.
- Nancy Melcher represented Saint Barnabas at the ENGAGE Workshop led by the City of West Allis to learn about resources available to us and network with other area organizations.
- Resulting from ENGAGE, we are building collaborations with the Wood Dale Neighborhood Association (which surrounds the St. Augustine site) and the City Center Neighborhood Association (which surrounds the Holy Assumption site).

### ***Priorities for Next Term***

- Continuing to bring together our committees and ministries
- Developing leaders and leadership skills throughout the parish
- Improving communication between Pastoral Council and the parish
- Whatever else God brings to us

## **Actualizaciones del Consejo Pastoral**



### **Logros del Consejo Pastoral y Nuevos Miembros**

El Consejo Pastoral ha estado muy ocupado durante el último año. Gran parte de lo que logramos fue el trabajo fundacional de la nueva parroquia, que quizá no sea muy visible para los feligreses. A continuación, un resumen de lo que hemos logrado desde que nos convertimos en la Congregación Católica de San Bernabé:

- Se formó un comité de nombres para recomendar opciones de nombres al arzobispo (poco antes de que la fusión se hiciera oficial).
