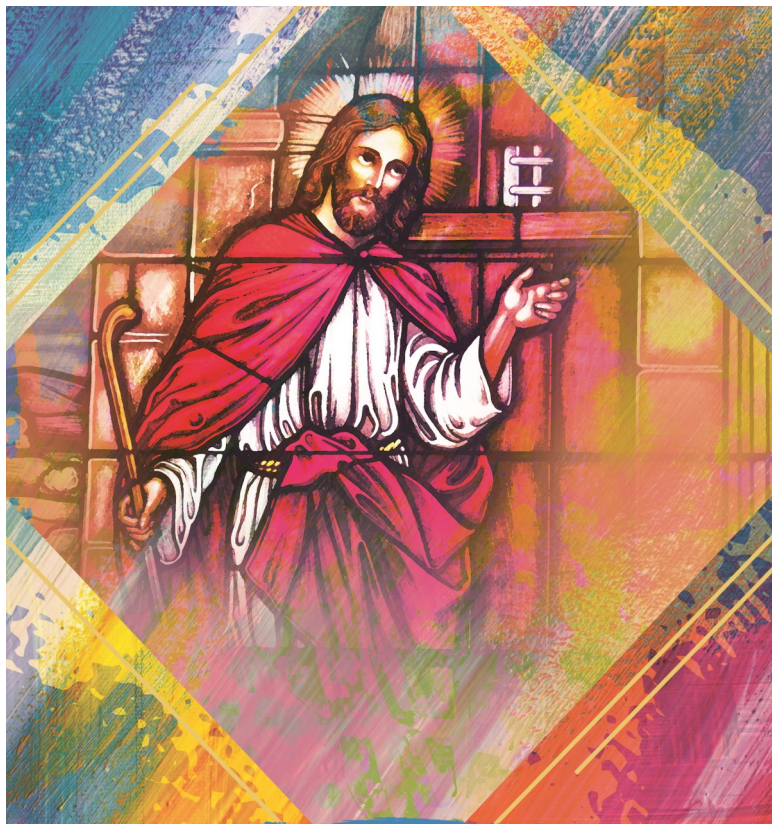

The new Pastoral Council met for the first time on July 16<sup>th</sup>. Much of the meeting was an orientation to Pastoral Council, but we did have several important discussions. First, we came up with a system to approve minutes more quickly and will be posting them on the website about two weeks after each meeting. Next, we discussed the role of officers and Commission liaisons, which will be finalized in August. Each Council member will be a liaison to a Commission, committee, or ministry, which will improve communication and collaboration around the parish. Finally, we had our first of what will be many conversations about supporting parishioners through potential building closures.
