



# How Do I join the Catholic Church? How Do I Receive My Sacraments? Attend OCIA Classes?

What is OCIA? St. Barnabas' Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) welcomes all adults and children approx. 7 years and older who would like to know more, join, or be fully received into the Catholic Faith. Our goal is to offer the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) to anyone who had not yet received them.

#### Who Should Join OCIA?

- Anyone 7 years or older not yet baptized who would like to become Catholic.
- Adults who have been baptized Catholic or other Christian Denomination but still need the Sacraments of Eucharist, Reconciliation and Confirmation.
- Adults who have children that have not yet been introduced to the faith. This
  could be from a mixed faith marriage or children 7 years or older who have
  not yet been baptized or baptized but have not received Eucharist or
  Confirmation.

#### ¿Cómo puedo integrarme a la Iglesia Catolica?

¿Cómo recibo Mis Sacramentos? ¿Puedo participar en las clases de OCIA?

¿Qué es el OCIA? El Orden de Iniciacion para adultos (OCIA) en San Bernabé da bienvenida a todo adulto y niños (as) mayores de 7 años que deseen aprender más o unirse y ser completamente aceptados en la fe católica.

Nuestra meta es proveer los Sacramentos de Iniciación (Bautismo, Eucaristía, and Confirmación) a toda persona que no los haya recibo.

#### ¿Quién debería unirse al OCIA?

- Cualquier persona mayor de 7 años que aún no haya sido bautizada y que quiera convertirse a la fe católica.
- Adultos que han sido bautizados como católicos u otra denominación cristiana, pero que aún necesitan los Sacramentos de la Eucaristía, la Reconciliación y la Confirmación.
- Adultos con hijos que aún no han sido introducidos a la fe. Pueden ser de matrimonios con fe mixtas o hijos de 7 años o más que aún no han sido bautizados, o bautizados no han recibido la Reconciliación, Eucaristía ni la Confirmación.
