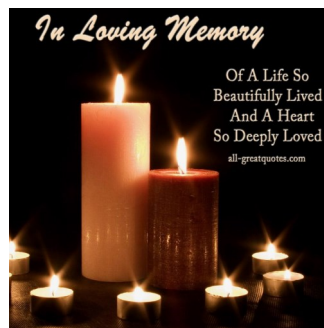

Finance Council News

A Mother's Heart Learning Center gave us a proposal for before and after day care at the Holy Assumption site. Finance Council recommends we explore renting to A Mother's Heart. We will begin paying our archdiocese and school assessments on a monthly basis instead of quarterly. The closing of the sale on the St. Rita site is still pending. We are finalizing Archdiocese approvals, as well as approval from the Vatican. The sites experienced some minor flooding which is being cared for internally. It is too early to report final numbers for the festival. Final results will be released later in September once all expenses have been received. The Renovation Committee continues to work with our vendors EUA, Berghammer and Joe Whitman on the renovation plan. We expect to have a Master Plan for the Holy Assumption site by January, 2026 which will be shared with the parishioners. We are putting a plan in place to raise money for our parishioners who realized devastation from the recent floods. September will be dedicated to this effort. More to come on this topic. We are still looking for volunteers to join our Finance Council subcommittees: Personnel, Technology and Investments. If you are interested please contact a Finance Council member.

Dear Parishioners,

At the request of Archbishop Grob, our parish will be taking up a special collection to support humanitarian relief for our suffering brothers and sisters in Gaza and the surrounding areas of the Middle East.

The ongoing crisis has created a dire situation for Christians and other innocent victims of violence, many of whom are struggling to survive without basic necessities. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has noted with great sorrow that "Gaza is starving."

The funds we collect will be sent to the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) and Catholic Relief Services (CRS), two organizations with a strong presence in the region. They are providing critical food, shelter, medical care, and emotional support to those in need.

We will hold a second collection at Mass next weekend, August 30th and 31st to support this urgent cause. You can also send contributions directly to the Parish Office noting the donation is for Gaza.

Your generosity is a powerful sign of our solidarity with this community.

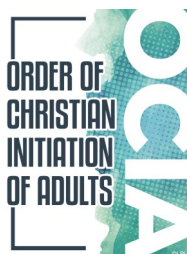
