



#### A Special Collection for Gaza and the Middle East

Dear Parishioners,

At the request of Archbishop Grob, our parish will be taking up a special collection to support humanitarian relief for our suffering brothers and sisters in Gaza and the surrounding areas of the Middle East.

The ongoing crisis has created a dire situation for Christians and other innocent victims of violence, many of whom are struggling to survive without basic necessities. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has noted with great sorrow that "Gaza is starving."

The funds we collect will be sent to the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) and Catholic Relief Services (CRS), two organizations with a strong presence in the region. They are providing critical food, shelter, medical care, and emotional support to those in need.

We will hold a second collection at Mass this weekend, August 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> to support this urgent cause. You can also send contributions directly to the Parish Office noting the donation is for Gaza.

Your generosity is a powerful sign of our solidarity with this community.

#### St Barnabas Support of Flood Victims




